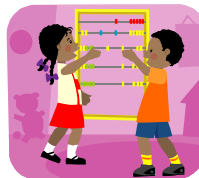
**KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION 2012-2013**

Please note that Chemistry 11 and Law 12 will be written on Tuesday morning instead on Monday morning as originally scheduled.

Grades 10, 11 and 12 will have no regular classes on Monday, Jan. 23 or Tuesday, Jan. 24.

Grades 10, 11 and 12 will begin regular second semester classes on Wednesday Jan. 25.

Grade 11 students and Communications 12 students will have Thursday period 1 and 2 off, and begin their day with period 3 at 11:05.

English 12 students can join their third period after they complete their exam.

Students writing exams are not to bring any papers, books or electronic communication devices into the exam room. Students must remain in the examination room for a minimum of 1 hour.

Students arriving more than ½ hour late will not be permitted into the exam room.

All students writing exams are expected to leave the building when they have completed their exam unless they wish to study quietly in the library or have other specific business in the school.
